Volunteer Position Description

Location: Community gardens throughout Spence Neighbourhood, and the Spence Neighbourhood Association office at 615 Ellice Ave.

Time Commitment: Approximately 5-10 hours per month. Flexible.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Design and construct raised garden beds, benches, tables, signs and other garden infrastructure with tools and materials supplied by Spence Neighbourhood Association.
- Repair existing raised beds and compost bins.
- Attend monthly Environment and Open Spaces Committee meetings.
- Other duties as assigned.

Skills & Qualifications:

- Must be skilled and experienced in basic carpentry and construction.
- Proficient with power tools.
- Physically capable to lift, bend and manipulate large objects.
- Able to work alone or with other volunteers with limited supervision.
- Valid Drivers' Licence and access to a van or pick-up truck is an asset.
- Experience installing and repairing chain-link fencing, eaves troughs and other handyperson tasks are assets.
