**WHO:** Participation on the board is open to anyone who lives, works or volunteers in the Spence neighbourhood and who is over 18 years old.

## WHAT BOARD POSITIONS ARE AVAILABLE?

We are recruiting for the following positions for a two-year term running from January 2022 to January 2024. We are looking for Area Directors in three areas (see description below) and up to 4 Directors-at-Large.

**Area 2** - Sargent Avenue to Notre Dame Avenue between Sherbrook Street and Langside Street

**Area 6** - Sargent Avenue to Ellice Avenue between Langside Street and Balmoral Street

**Area 8** - Ellice Avenue to Portage Avenue between Balmoral Street and Sherbrook Street.

## THERE ARE TWO TYPES OF SNA BOARD DIRECTORS

### Area Directors:

Area Directors are nominated by members of their area. They can seek endorsement by the nominating committee or if they are not endorsed, can still stand at the January Annual General Meeting (AGM.)

### Directors at Large:

Directors at Large are nominated from the floor at the January AGM, and can also be endorsed by the nominating committee.
