



Youth DJ Workshop

Youth DJ Workshop is an opportunity for youths to learn the basic components of DJing as well as explore a new skill that they can leverage to build a career in the future. The workshop is designed to provide a thorough introduction to the fundamental skills of DJing and help youth decide on the next step on becoming a professional DJ.

The workshop runs on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6.30pm - 9.30pm at the MERC, 430 Langside and is facilitated by renowned multiple World DMC champion DJ Brace. Participants will be using professional industry standard equipment: Rane TWELVE MKII Turntables and Rane SEVENTY TWO MKII 2-Channel Battle Mixer. In the fully equipped, relaxed, and inspiring environment, youths are guided through two hours of fun-filled exercises designed to maximize hands-on time navigating the traditional two turntable and mixer setup.


